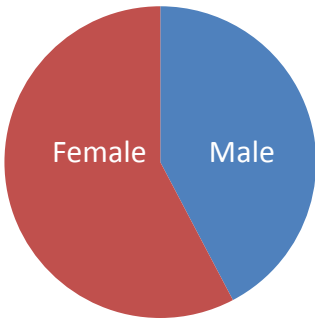


Twyford 2020 Progress Report Questionnaire Results

Introduction

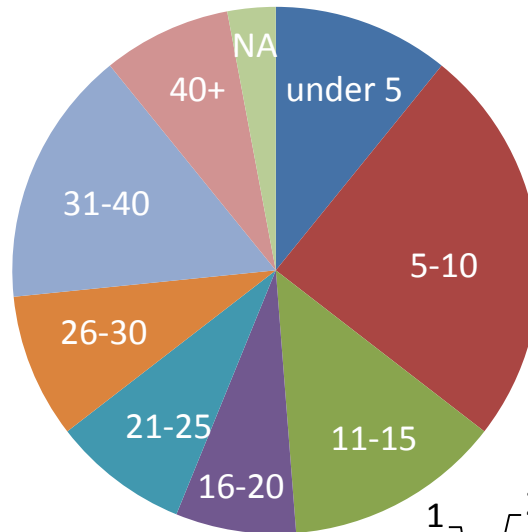
- In November 2014 Twyford and Ruscombe residents were invited to complete a questionnaire to support the Twyford 2020 Progress Report
- Residents were asked about changes to the village over the last 5 years, subjects becoming more/less important to them, their priorities for the next 5 years and the potential impact of Crossrail
- 205 people responded (136 online)

Who were these 205 people?

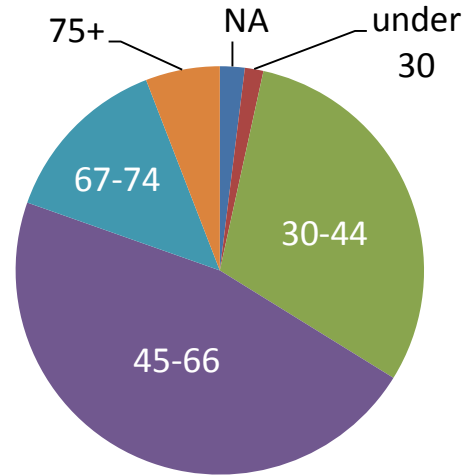


Gender

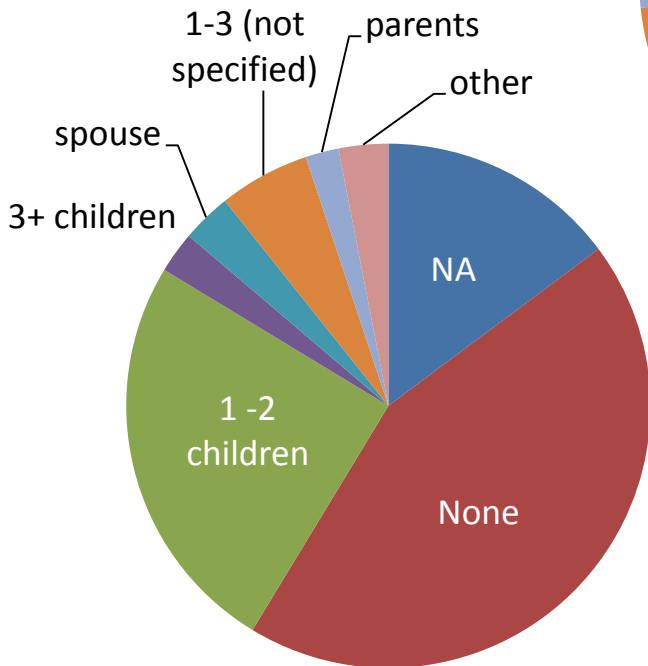
Years living in the village



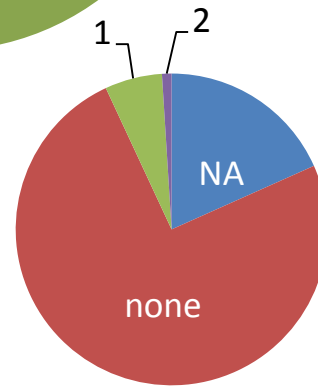
A cross-section of residents are represented but the absence of younger people is notable

Number of disabled people in household

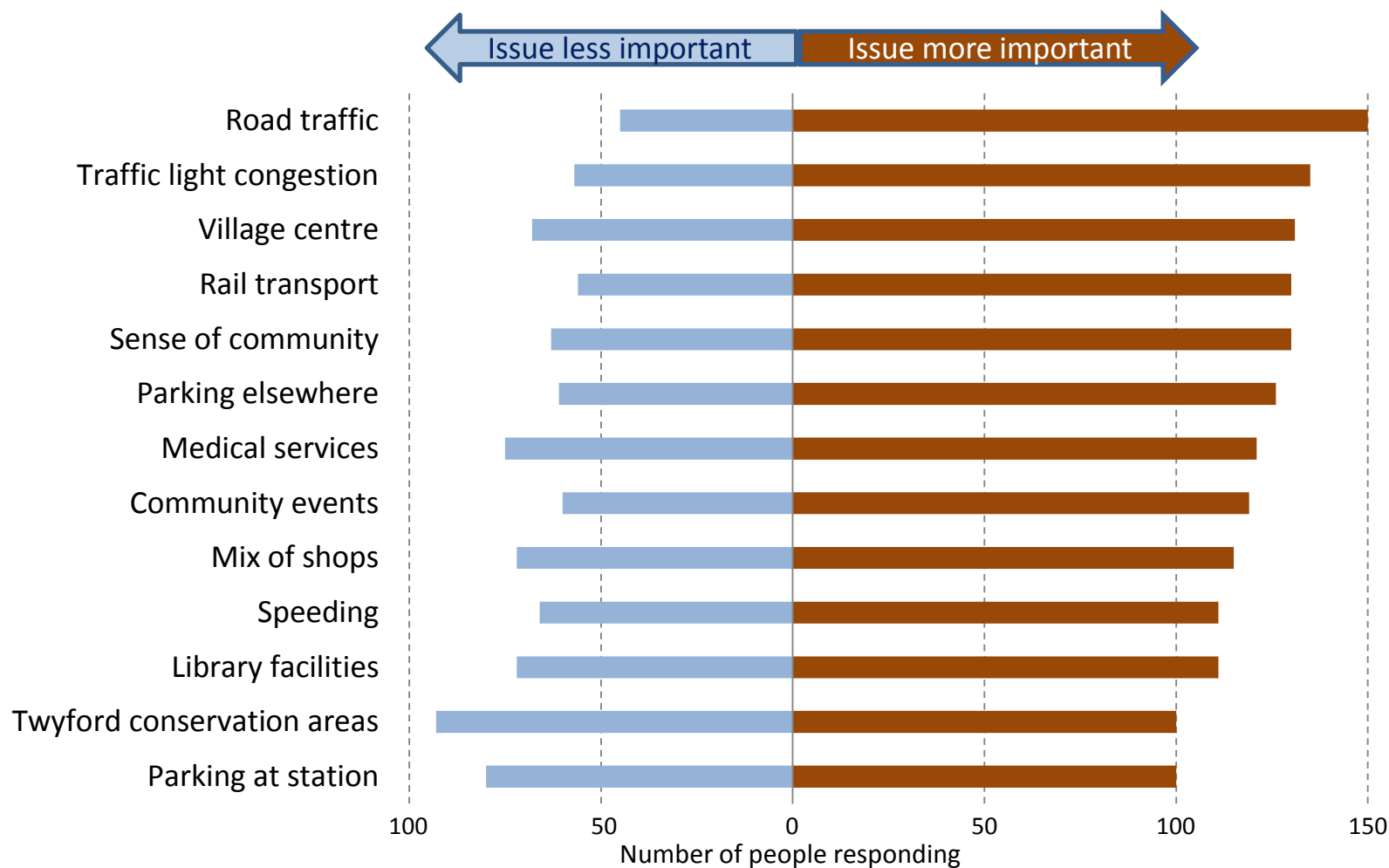
The size of the pie slice is the % of answers in each category

What has been the single, most significant change in the village over the last 5 years?



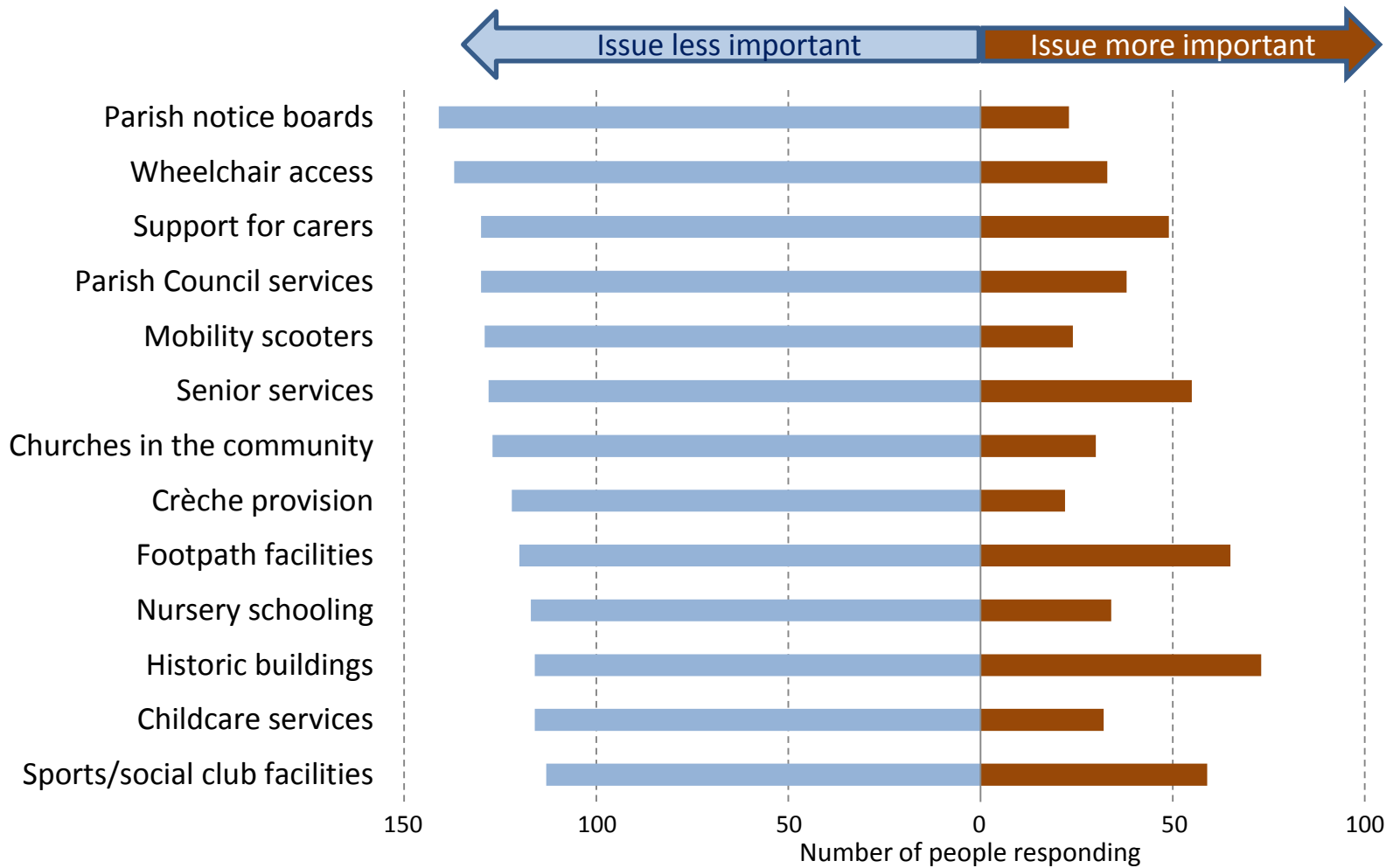
Larger text size indicates that change was mentioned by more people

Issues that have grown in importance for village residents over the last 5 years



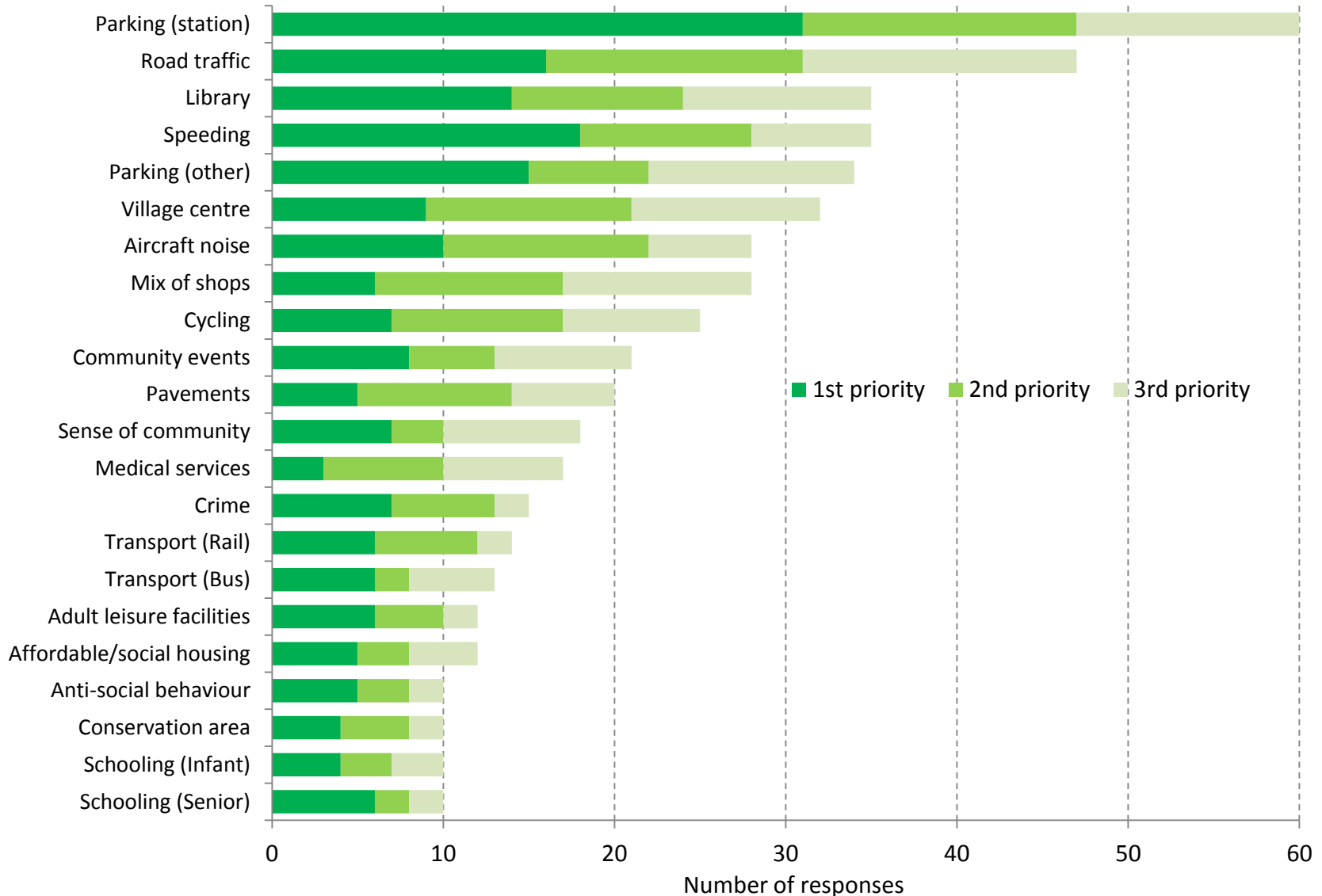
Issues (out of a list of 54) indicated by 100+ people as being more important now than 5 years ago

Issues that have reduced in importance for village residents over the last 5 years



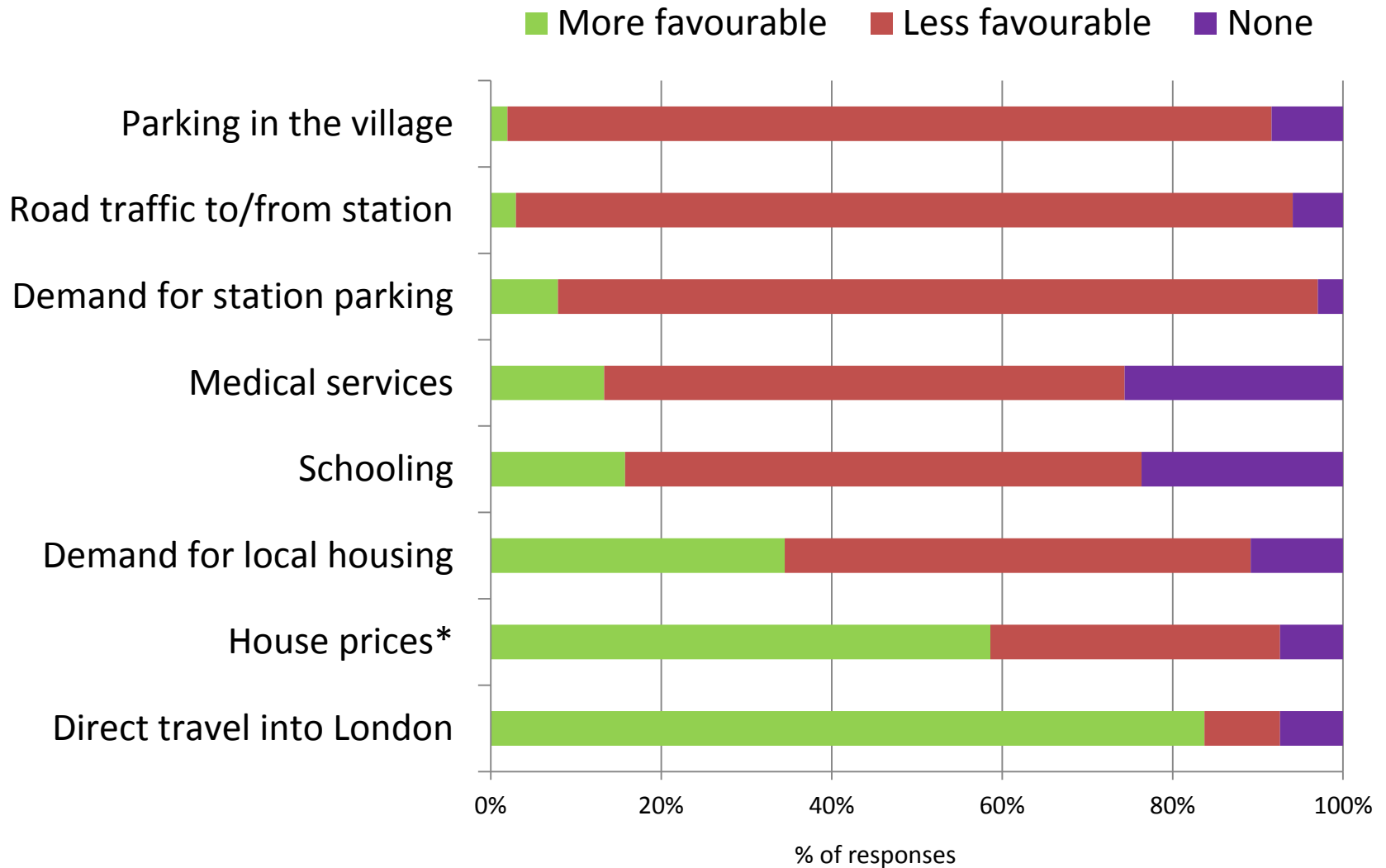
Main issues (out of a list of 54) indicated by people as being less important now than 5 years ago
